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As A Level Student Text

Find out at which level to start a student. Determine when a student is ready to move to the next level. The Flesch-Kincaid Grade Level outputs a U.S. school grade level; this indicates the average student in that grade level can read the text. For example, a score of 7.4 indicates that the text is understood by an average student in 7th grade. 3.
