Peddars Way and Norfolk Coast Path. A walk along The Norfolk Coast Path National Trail is the perfect way to lose yourself in this magical land of sand dunes and salt marsh, sea air and warm welcomes. Peddars Way has a different character altogether.

Combined with the Norfolk Coast Path, it forms the Peddars Way & Norfolk Coast Path National Trail, one of 15 National Trails in England and Wales. Much of the Peddars Way can be used by cyclists and there is a special route available to horseriders.

The Peddars Way may be accessed by public transport. There is a path linking the southern end, at Knettishall Heath, to the nearby Harling Road railway station . Holme, at the northern end, has a regular bus service to King's Lynn and Hunstanton .

Norfolk Hills. The highest point in Norfolk is 103m above sea level: Beeston Bump, the highest point on the Norfolk Coast Path and Peddars Way National Trail, is a mere 63 metres high, a minor blip in a county famed for being as flat as a pancake.

#### **Peddars Way And Norfolk Coast Path | 10 Mile Hike**

Norfolk Coast Path and Peddars Way. Peddars Way and the Norfolk Coast Path follows the National Trail that starts in Knettishall, amid the forest strewn borders of Norfolk and Suffolk ending at Cromer, on the North Norfolk Heritage Coast. Peddars Way was one of the earliest roads to be built in the county, shortly after AD61.

#### **Walking Holidays on the Norfolk Coast Path and Peddars Way ...**

The Norfolk Coast Path is a fairly modern walking route, created from a network of existing footpaths and newly-created ones to link the coastal end of the Peddars Way (which starts at Knettishall Heath Country Park in Suffolk) to Hopton-on-Sea. The Peddars Way and Norfolk Coast Path became joined as a Long Distance National Trail in 1986.

The Peddars Way is a wonderful ever changing, easy graded, 46 mile long distance walk starting from the pretty woodland of Knettishall Heath, through to open countryside and tracks, past historic pingo ponds, quiet lanes and heathland, along arrow straight old Roman roads and tracks and eventually ending at the sand and sea on the North Norfolk Coast at Holme-next-the-Sea.
