Guidelines for Conducting Waterfront Skills Review Course

The course cannot be conducted if the video segments are not available. Starting in the water, swim 20 yards. The face may be in or out of the water. Swim goggles are not allowed. Surface dive to a depth of 6 feet, swim 10 to 15 feet along the bottom to retrieve a 10-pound object. Return to the surface and swim on the back to...

Red Cross Waterfront Module: The waterfront module, which is only valid with a current Lifeguarding Certificate, is designed to train pool lifeguards in working non-surf beaches. You will be trained in using mask & fins, searching shallow & deep water areas, and using a rescue board. Training will occur in both pool and waterfront.
